Notice on the Prevention of Infection with a Novel Coronavirus

Numerous cases of pneumonia caused by a novel coronavirus have recently been reported in Chinese regions, including Hubei province. As a precautionary measure, entrants from China are advised to follow the instructions below. This will help early detect such pneumonia cases and prevent the spread of the infection.

|| What are major symptoms?

• Fever (37.5°C or above) and respiratory symptoms (e.g. coughs, sore throats, etc.)

|| Who should pay attention?

 \cdot Those who visited or stayed in Chinese regions, including Hubei province within 14 days.

|| How can I protect myself?

• Wear a mask; cover your mouth and nose with an upper sleeve when coughing; and wash your hands.

|| What should I do after returning to Korea?

- If you develop a fever or any respiratory symptoms (e.g. coughs, etc.) within 14 days of returning to Korea, please call the KCDC Call Center at 1339 and consult a doctor at a screening clinic.
- If you have any respiratory symptoms, wear a mask. Importantly, wearing a mask is a must when you go outside or visit a medical clinic or a hospital. Also, if you have such symptoms, wash your hands as well with running water for more than 30 seconds.
- When you visit a medical clinic or a hospital, tell your doctor your overseas travel history: the fact that you visited or stayed in Chinese regions, including Hubei province.

% In accordance with paragraph 5 of Article 76-2 of the Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act, the records of your overseas travel shall be delivered to medical institutions to provide information for medical diagnosis and treatment. No relevant information shall be used for any other purpose than infectious disease prevention, and such relevant information shall be deleted immediately after an incubation period of 14 days.





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
